## **Comments**

• There are approximately 200 conceptions among under 18 year females each year across the tri-borough area. Around one third of these result in birth and the remainder in abortion

• The under 18 conception rate in Kensington and Chelsea is significantly lower than the London and England averages. Hammersmith & Fulham is higher than London, and Westminster is similar

•College Park & Old Oak, Wormholt & White City, Queen's Park, Harrow Road and Church Street wards have significantly higher under 18 conceptions compared to England



#### Under 18 year old conceptions per 1,000 female population age 15-17, 1998-2010






## **Comments**

• Hammersmith Fulham's under 18 conception rate has fallen substantially over the past decade. However it remains slightly higher than the London and England averages

• The Kensington & Chelsea rate has dropped by two thirds since 1998 and, in 2010, had the lowest rate of any London borough

 Whilst the rate has decreased in Westminster, it has been broadly in line with the national and London trends
